

# ACCESS AND SENSORY NOTES

## **Assistance:**

In the courtyard and in the space there are Access Pilots.

These are people wearing green vests or green armbands.

They can support with communication, orientation, and unforeseen needs. Please do not hesitate to approach them if you have a problem or a request.

## **Duration:**

The event lasts 4 hours.

Your experience within it might take anything between 30 minutes and 2 hours.

You can take breaks or leave whenever you need or want to.

## **Interaction:**

‘A Fanzine Duet’ is an interactive performance with 1 partner.

This interaction is lead by a fanzine read together. The fanzine proposes talking, dancing and listening together.

You can opt out of any of those interactions if you prefer.

**Placing:**

Beanbags, chairs, mats, stools and benches are arranged in pairs in the space.

You can choose any placing that suits you.

If you require a specific place, please contact the Access Pilots.

**Space:**

Next to the different seating and laying options in the space, there are small plastic toy animals in groups on the floor or tables.

Please contact an Access Pilot to get through the space safely. At the same time, you should know that it is not a problem in case they break.

**Sight:**

‘A Fanzine Duet’ is based on reading together. You can also choose to have it read aloud by a screenreader.

There are screenreader versions available via a qr code on the walls of the space. Please contact the Access pilots to guide you there.

**Sound:**

There will be sounds from people reading in the space and, at times, ambient music in a low volume.

You can also choose to be outside in the courtyard, in the garden or in the tent if you prefer a more quiet surrounding.

**Temperature:**

The room temperature is around 20 degrees.

There are blankets and hot water bottles available. Please contact the Access Pilots to get you what you need.

**Drinks:**

There is water and cups in the space. You can either help yourself or ask an Access Pilot to assist you.

**Decompression space:**

In the courtyard there is a decompression space with a weighted blanket, wool blanket, sleep masks, hot water bottle, ear muffs, water, sugar, and stim toys.

If you would like to go there, you can ask an Access Pilot to accompany you.
